Lyons reported that the budget request submitted for 2018-2019 was for \$421 500 in accordance with planned staff wage increases and certain IT/infrastructure costs no longer being billed directly to the council and answered questions. Consensus to adopt the revised 2017-2018 budget.

3.5 Presentation on Reconciliation

• B. Martin presented on Reconciliation and the work that the council could do to support this movement. C. Sewell offered follow up commentary and a discussion ensued.

4. Member Updates

- o M. Nickerson provided updates on the hiring of midwives
- o J. Richard reported that calls to the Fredericton Sexual Assault Centre's support line have tripled in last year and that many involve cases of complex trauma. J. Richard stated there are challenges with volunteer burn out and a lack of funding, which is presenting across the country as well as at the centre.
- L.C. Boudreau reported that the Regroupement féministe du Nouveau-Brunswick is presently working on education on consent for children in school and, in particularly, how to better equip nurses to discuss consent with children.

- o Members attended a public engagement event for the council's Resonate initiative.
